Gösta Ullmark



Gösta Ullmark studied medicine at Karolinska Institutet, Stockholm and qualified in 1981. He completed his MD thesis at the orthopedic department of Gävle sjukhus, Uppsala University 2001. His surgical practice has been oriented to prosthetic hip and knee, including primary surgery and revision replacements.

Some contributions of Mr Ullmark to arthroplasty include the introduction of surgical instruments for Impaction Bone Grafting for Hip and Knee prosthesis. Ullmark have also introduced surgical implants for restoring segmental Acetabular bone defects.

His fields of research have mainly been connected to results of hip and knee arthroplasty. Another field of research has been Positron Emission Tomography analyses in orthopedics. He was president of European Hip Society (EHS) 2014 to 2016. Presently he is chairman of EHS Educational Committee, arranging fellowships, engaging speakers and arranging lectures and symposia at national and international congresses.
